- 6) Monitoring and coordinating activities for children (e.g. bounce-about, handing out of gifts, games).

Adults may wish to take their games (dominos, pictionary, etc) to the park. Men, are you interested in organising a football game? This would be a welcomed addition to the activities.

We are expecting to have a Karaoke machine especially for the teenagers, here we are hoping to have talents exposed.

We would like to have your input regarding this event. Therefore you are being requested to attend the next Community meeting which will be held on November 14, 2004.

We look forward to your cooperation in this our community event.
